## Sources of new ideas & knowledge

PID implies openness for multiple sources:

- Research organizations: are we, our organizations, linked well enough to benefit from this resource?
- Other development organizations: do we exchange and share enough?
- Farmers, those we work with as well as others elsewhere: are we alert for innovations from farmers?

The heart of PID is **combining views**, ideas, from different sources;

Central issue is making **the choice** of what to work on, what to try, **transparent.** 

## Start with looking at farmer innovations?

- Recognizing farmers own efforts in innovation; development changes the way farmer, extension and research understand and respect each other;
- Creates a positive momentum as it focuses on peoples capacities and initiatives rather than their problems;
- It thus builds a dynamic of self-confidence rather than dependency on outsiders for bringing useful new ideas;
- Innovations developed may fit more easily with local realities;
- At least give space to innovative ideas and suggestions in activities proposed by us.
