Sources of new ideas & knowledge

PID implies openness for **multiple sources**:

- *Research organizations*: are we, our organizations, linked well enough to benefit from this resource?
- *Other development organizations*: do we exchange and share enough?
- *Farmers*, those we work with as well as others elsewhere: are we alert for innovations from farmers?

The heart of PID is **combining views**, ideas, from different sources;

Central issue is making **the choice** of what to work on, what to try, **transparent**.



Start with looking at farmer innovations?

- Recognizing farmers own efforts in innovation; development **changes the way** farmer, extension and research **understand** and **respect each other**;
- Creates **a positive momentum** as it focuses on peoples capacities and initiatives rather than their problems;
- It thus builds **a dynamic of self-confidence** rather than dependency on outsiders for bringing useful new ideas;
- Innovations developed may **fit more easily with local realities**;
- At least give space to innovative ideas and suggestions in activities proposed by us.
